Matt Murdoch Curling Foundation are delighted to announce another unique opportunity for junior curlers from Scotland to attend the Trillium Curling Camp in Canada.

This Trust initiative has been possible through continued support and funding donations in memory of Matt Murdoch, a keen local curler and Rotarian from Lockerbie.

Trillium Curling Camp runs over two weeks and hosts 96 junior curlers each week. The selected juniors will attend 'Week A' and will receive coaching from the best coaches from Ontario and across Canada who make the camp a wonderful experience for those involved. Guest presenters in the past have included Brad Gushue, Mark Nichols, Kaitlyn Lawes and Scotland's David Murdoch, Michael Goodfellow, Scott Andrews and Hammy McMillan to name just a few.

CAMP INFORMATION

The 2024 Trillium Curling Camp will take place from **11-16 August** at the Albert McCormick Community Center, Waterloo, Ontario with accommodation at the Wilfred Laurier University.

Two spaces have been allocated by the organisers in the Advanced category for curlers who must have a strong level of competitive experience. Selected athletes will be accompanied by a suitable chaperone, who will also coach at the camp.

MMCF will cover the below aspects of the trip for successful applicants:

- Camp fee (inclusive of all meals, accommodation and activities).
- Any required accommodation before/after camp, and transfers when in Canada.
- Medical, travel and loss of property insurance for the duration of the trip.

Successful applicants will be responsible for:

Cost of return flights to Canada, up to a cost of £1000.
(MMCF will arrange flights, and cover any airfare costs which exceed £1000)

- Age 15-17 at time of camp
- Scottish Curling member
- Resident in Scotland
- Skill Award Level: Silver/Advanced
